[History]

Guangxi University of Science and Technology (GXUST) was established in 1958, with 60 years of history.

[Location]

GXUST is located in the CBD of Liuzhou, an important industrial and tourist city with convenient transportation and supporting facilities in southwest China.

[Introduction]

Under the direct jurisdiction of the government of Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region, GXUST is a university with 2 teaching hospitals, offering programs in the nine disciplines: engineering, management, science, medicine, economics, liberal arts, law, art, and pedagogy, with the major emphasis on engineering. The University has 3 campuses: Donghuan, Liushi and Liudong, covering over 310 hectares of land. The university currently has over 25,000 full-time students as well as employing more than 1400 full-time faculty. It includes 20 schools, 19 research centers, 4 affiliated hospitals, offering 77 bachelor degree programs in total. In addition, the university has 3 master degree programs of first-level discipline, 21 master degree programs of second-level discipline, 2 professional master degree programs, and is currently applying for accreditation on three doctorate degrees.

[International Education]

Guangxi University of Science and Technology has committed to offer quality education. The university maintains close relations with the students and their parents, starting before admission to after graduation. At present, the university has enrolled students from U.S.A., Canada, U.K., Ireland, Germany, Japan, Republic of Korea, Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Laos, Vietnam, Pakistan, Russia, Mongolia, Kyrgyzstan and Peru to study Chinese language and degree programs. Authorized by Confucius Institute Headquarter (Hanban), GXUST is one of the online examination centers for HSK and HSKK and organizes the test several times each year for the students in and around Liuzhou.

[Scholarships]

The qualified students can apply for the Guangxi Government Scholarships for Students from ASEAN Countries and GXUST Scholarships for International Students.



[Significant Achievements of University - Enterprise Cooperation]

GXUST is located in Liuzhou, the largest industrial city in southwest China, and is a pioneer in university-enterprise cooperation. More than 40 large or medium-sized enterprises have become the members of GXUST's Board of Trustees. 


The international student office provides allround and effective assistance to the students, including pre-orientation, visa service, insurance consultation, shuttle bus service, etc..



(5) Book your flight, inform your date arrival time and confirm the airport pick-up with GXUST (free pick-up available on some scheduled dates).

(1) Please be sure to arrive the airport at least 2 hours before the departure time for international flights, and 1 hour for the domestic flight.

(2) Bring your passport (visa), Admission Notice, and a small amount of cash (about 1000 CNY).

Please confirm the restriction on luggage weight with the airline.



1. What is the security situation in GXUST?

GXUST is one of the safest campuses in Guangxi and it has been awarded the honor of "Secure and Civilized Campus" for 9 consecutive years to now. The university employs full-time security and dormitory administration staff to provide 24-hour service for the students. However, the students should still take good care of their own valuables. Please lock the door of your dormitory while you are away.



3 Can I apply for the bachelor degree program without a HSK Certificate (Level 4)?

Yes. But you are required to pass the Chinese language test organized by GXUST. If fail, you can take our Chinese language program and join the degree program after meeting the language requirement. The reason why you have to meet the language requirement is that HSK-4 certificate is one of the conditions for granting a degree.





2 What is the climate like in Liuzhou?

The climate in Liuzhou is moderate with an annual average temperature of 21°C. During July and August, the hottest season in a year, the average temperature is about 29°C and the maximum is 39°C. During the coldest January and February, the average temperature is 10°C. The rainfall is abundant in Liuzhou which is 1400–1500mm in a year.



4. What about the medical insurance in China?

According to the government requirement, international students who stay in China for more than 3 months are required to purchase medical insurance. The Comprehensive Medical Insurance of Foreign Students in China is recommended.

5. What household items shall I bring for daily use?

The dormitory is equipped with air conditioner, laundry machine, water heater, etc. The students will bring their own bedding or buy it at the campus store or local market.







Situated in the center of Guangxi, Liuzhou is a beautiful, eco-industrial, and premier tourist city with an well-established history and culture. Liuzhou is divided into 6 counties and 4 districts, housing a population of 3.8 million people who belong to 44 different ethnic groups: Han, Zhuang, Miao, Yao, Dong, etc.

Liuzhou was officially established in the West Han Dynasty over 2100 years ago. Liu Zongyuan, a famous poet and writer in the Tang Dynasty had served as the Governor of Liuzhou and spent the rest of his life in Liuzhou. His temple, cenotaph as well as some epigraphs written by him are carefully kept in the city. Liuzhou is also the Cradle of South China's prehistoric civilizations, as the Liujiang People and Bailian cavemen lived here at least 50 thousand years ago.

Liuzhou is surrounded by green mountains, through which the meandering Liujiang River flows through, hence its glorious nickname of 'the World's Best Natural Bonsai'. Some talented and famous poets in history praised Liuzhou in their poems, "Trees over trees cover nearly everything, winding rivers bends itself beautifully" (Liu Zongyuan), and "Thousands of peaks stand around the city, flowing river embraces the town" (Xu Xiake), which are vivid depictions of Liuzhou's charming scenery. Liuzhou is also known as the "Stone Capital of China" since "stones in Liuzhou are unique and the oddest in China". As the birthplace of Liu Sanjie (a famous and popular folk song singer in ancient history), Liuzhou is also a place where folk songs are extremely popular. Liuzhou has kept its unique and special folk lore and traditions: the Zhuang people's songs, the Yao people's dances, the Miao people's festivals and the Dong people's houses are known as the "4 Wonders of Liuzhou". Chengyang's Wind & Rain Bridge as well as the drum-towers in Sanjiang County are included in the list of the national cultural heritage and enjoy worldwide praise and fame.

Liuzhou is an important industrial manufacturing city in the southwest of China. With the automobile, machinery and metallurgy industries as its backbones, as well as the chemical, sugar-making, paper-making, pharmacy, building materials, cosmetics industries etc, all contributing to Liuzhou's gross industrial output, that accounts for 20% of that in Guangxi. Investments from automotive giants such as General Motors, Nissan, Shanghai Automotive Industry Corporation, and China FAW Group Corporation have turned Liuzhou's

automobile industry into its cornerstone, making it one of China's leading national automotive production center and one of the national export bases for automobiles and automotive parts as well. Liuzhou has many famous automobile brands, such as SGMW, Dongfeng Chenglong, Dongfeng Fengxing (MPV), etc. There are also other world famous brands which include LiuGong Machinery, OVM Pre-stressed Anchorage Device, Liuzhou Steel, Golden Throat Lozenges, LMZ Toothpaste, Wangshan Refined Sugar, etc.

Over the years, Liuzhou has made significant improvements in its healthy, environmental, economic and social development. The goal is to transform the city into a sustainable, modern and eco-friendly city that is suitable both for living and doing business. Liuzhou has also established the city brand of "Eco-industrial Liuzhou, Sustainable Entrepreneurial City". The urban air quality in 2011 and 2012 was rated at 95% (excellent). The water quality of the Liujing River is ranked No.1 in Guangxi, and the quality of drinking water at the sources of Liujiang River is ranked as 3rd-level surface water in line with national standards.

During his inspection in 2006, the former Premier Wen Jiabao visited Liuzhou and praised the city as "Liuzhou is a city with green mountains, clear water, and excellent environment". Premier Li Keqiang also made his comment: "Liujiang River is as good as Lijiang River of Guilin, and Liuzhou can compete with Guilin". In 2012, Liuzhou received the title of "the National Forest City" after taking first place in the national comprehensive urban environment assessment and first place in the provincial environmental protection satisfaction survey.

In 2012, with all its competitive advantages, Liuzhou was awarded the titles of "Top Ten Innovative City in China" and the "The Most Harmonious Satisfied City" among nearly 700 cities in China, which make the city more bright and attractive.
